## **RESEARCH ITEMS**

### 1. INBRE

Committee members also discussed the mission of INBRE, the need to continue build ing on the research work with tribal colleges and working with legislation for more research funding.

### 2. EPSCoR

The committee discussed the necessary cross connection between NDSU and UND for both EPSCOR and INBRE to elevate research within the state. They identified the grants are not identical and that EPSCoR and INBRE have different requirements that need to be fulfilled. They recognized the funding is limited but stated the efforts to work with various types of industry and stakeholders across the state remains a vital component to expand research in the State . Both EPSCoR and INBRE will be working together to collaborate and/or contract with the other nine colleges and tribal colleges on research initiatives .

President Bresciani stated that there is work efforts being done in every county of the state and the five tribe s remain essential on both the research and economic development fronts. He stated they have people in various locations working consistently and positively with each tribal community within the ND stat e borders.

Williston State College will provide a presentation on their research initiative to the committee at the next meeting.
